# A. <u>Public Hearing (tabled)</u> – Home Occupation - Grzybowski

# **B.** <u>Public Hearing (tabled)</u> – Babcock

The Township has received a request from Shawn James on behalf of Travis Babcock for a Special Land Use permit to construct a pond on parcel number 70-04-07-100-039, located on Ranger Court, a private street off Taft Street. A new document was provided to the Commission, an aerial view of the property depicting location and setbacks for a smaller proposed pond, location of the future dwelling, spoils placement area and other relevant data.

Chairman Bill Sanders opened the Public Hearing.

A **motion** was made by Commissioner Rich Suchecki to take the application off the table for further review. A 2<sup>nd</sup> was offered by Commissioner Ryan Arends. The motion was unanimously approved.

Those present for this hearing were Shawn James, 18739 144<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Spring Lake; Margaret Babcock, 16556 Taft, Spring Lake; and citizen (neighbor) Patricia Kitchen, 14170 Taft.

Z/A Robert Toland led in with a summarization of the application. Shawn James confirmed with a narrative of the aerial view document. Patricia Kitchen stated she was present to make sure everything was legal. Shawn James added that he had contacted Jenny Bolt at the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), that there are no wetland concerns and provided the Township with supporting documentation.

All public comments heard, the Commission found the request to be in compliance with Township Ordinance and a **motion** to approve the request was made by Commissioner Rich Suchecki. A 2<sup>nd</sup> was offered by Commissioner Roy Holmes. The motion was unanimously approved.

Chairman Bill Sanders closed the Public Hearing.

C. Zoning Ordinance Amendments – Resolution of intent to hold a Public Hearing

The Planning Commission, on its own initiative, is proposing to amend the Crockery Township Ordinance for enhanced harmonization with current conditions and the Township Comprehensive Plan. The Commission reviewed Draft No. 3 of the proposal. A **motion** was made by Commissioner Mike Munch to hold a public hearing in this matter on April 19, 2016, at 7:30 PM, at the Township Hall. A 2<sup>nd</sup> was offered by Commissioner Roy Holmes. The motion was unanimously approved.
