Agenda Item 2. Approval of the Agenda

Agenda Item 6. Public Comment

Supervisor Leon Stille spoke to the history and current standing of the M-104 Corridor Overlay District, specifically supporting the concept of service drives and connected parking areas now required by Ordinance. Mr. Redick also commented on the requirements associated with service drives found in the Ordinance.

Agenda Item 7. Action Items

A. Zaidel – Special Land Use – Pond- Public Hearing.

The Planning Commission has received a request from James Zaidel for a Special Land Use permit to construct a 7,100 SF pond on Parcel #70-04-03-400-013, 2.74 acres, located at 18729 112th Avenue. This parcel is currently zoned Ag-2 Rural/Agricultural Preservation.

Documents provided to the Commission for this hearing include; (1) a Planning and Zoning Review by Z/A Toland, dated August 20, 2019, discussing this proposal, (2) a Site Plan by Driesenga & Associates, Inc., Grand Rapids, Michigan, Project 1910016.1A, as amended May 22, 2019, by ARG, with attached cross-section B – B, (3) a Crockery Township Zoning Application, signed by James Zaidel, dated June 7, 2019, (4) a color Ottawa County GIS aerial showing subject parcel and surrounding plots, and (5) an EGLE permit #WRP016585v.1, dated June 5, 2019, issued by Bonnie Broadwater, Grand Rapids District Office.

Mr. James Zaidel was present for this hearing.

Chairman Bill Sanders open the public hearing.

Mr. Toland provided a lead-in to the discussion, covering his Review and stating Mr. Zaidel had acquired the necessary local and State permits.

The Commission discussed the request with Mr. Zaidel and reviewed the site plan. The Commission found the proposal to be acceptable.

Chairman Sanders asked for public comment. None was offered.

After all discussion was complete, and all interested parties were heard, a **motion, via resolution**, was made by Commissioner Ryan Arends to approve this Special Land Use, a 7100 SF pond, to be constructed on Parcel #70-04-03-400-013. A 2nd was offered by Commissioner Dave Meekhof. The motion was unanimously approved by the Commission.

Agenda Item 8. Presentations

A. Proposed Zoning Amendments – Signs, Accessory Buildings, Others.

The Commission discussed the draft language provided, which included amendments regarding Real Estate Signs, Accessory Buildings, Parking Lot Connectors (definition), Service Drives (definition), Waterfront Setback Averaging, Uses Allowed by Right in AG-1 District, Special Land Uses in R-5 District, Fence Permits, Re-Alphabetizing of several sections.

The Commission reviewed and discussed the draft, making several changes and deletions to the proposed language.

A motion, via resolution, was made by Commissioner Rich Suchecki to Hold a Public Hearing regarding these proposed zoning amendments on Tuesday, September 17, 2019, at 7:30 P.M., at the Township Hall. A 2nd was offered by Commissioner Mike Munch. The motion was unanimously approved by the Commission.

Mr. David Willis was made aware of how to access a copy of the proposed language prior to the public hearing.

Agenda Item 9. Discussion Items

A. <u>Design Standards for service drives</u>.

A brief discussion took place on the matter, including increasing drive width to 24 feet.

B. Discuss areas for potential rezoning.
