CROCKERY TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING MINUTES SPECIAL MEETING HELD ON APRIL 26, 2022

- 1. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Erhorn at 5:00 p.m.
- 2. Roll call: Present: Erik Erhorn, Kathy Buchanan, Judy VanBemmelen, Ryan Kelly, Rich Suchecki.
- 3. Public comments were offered. No comments were heard.
- 4. Maggie McKeithan, the Director of the Spring Lake District Library was present for the discussion of possibly putting a library millage request on the August ballot. Maggie informed the board that approximately one-third of the Crockery residents have library cards, with Spring Lake residents at about 40% participation. The Spring Lake Library Board has agreed to renew the agreement for Crockery residents to be eligible for a library card if a millage request is approved by the voters.
- 5. Motion by VanBemmelen, seconded by Kelly to approve Resolution 2022-07, Resolution To Approve Ballot Proposal For Renewal Of Library Services Millage. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 6. Motion by Kelly, seconded by VanBemmelen to approve signing the agreement with Spring Lake District Library for Crockery residents to be eligible for library services if the millage request for library services is approved by the voters. The Supervisor and Clerk are authorized to sign the agreement. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 7. Motion by Kelly, seconded by VanBemmelen to adopt Ordinance 2022-01, An Ordinance To Adopt Local Watercraft Control Regulations (No Wake Zone) On A Portion Of The Grand River [Grand River: 96th Ave. downstream to westerly edge of parcel 70-04-36-300-010]. All in favor. Motion carried.
- 8. Motion by Kelly, seconded by Suchecki to rescind Resolution 2020-17. All in favor. Motion carried. (This resolution requested the DNR to approve a no wake zone for a portion of the Grand River along the Conestoga Campground. The DNR recommendation for Resolution 2020-18, Mezeske's no wake request includes the portion of the Grand River which runs in front of the campground so there is no need to proceed).

Motion by Kelly, seconded by Suchecki to adjourn the meeting. All in favor. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:22 p.m
