

Crockery Township Cemetery Rules

- ♦ Fencing, hedging, rock, stones, wood chips, of any kind are not permitted around or on any lot or grave. Ground plantings or trees are prohibited.
- ♦ All flowers and plants, including artificial, must be in approved urns of concrete or metal. Urns shall be placed to the side of the monument/grave marker and not in front or behind. One (1) urn per grave site. Flowers placed at grave site for funeral services may remain for not more than two weeks.
- ♦ Artificial flowers permitted between May 1 to Oct. 1
Winter wreaths permitted Nov. 1 to April 1.
Grave blankets are not allowed
- ♦ All monuments/markers must meet the materials & sizes allowed in the Ordinance. No handcrafted grave markers allowed.
- ♦ Shepherd hooks, wire, metal rods, solar lights, glass jars, decorations, ornaments, fences, benches (except a monument/marker bench serving as headstone), or other such materials are prohibited.
- ♦ The Cemetery reserves the right to remove anything from a grave which is a detriment to the natural beauty or items that will impede our ability to maintain the cemetery, without notice or compensation.
- ♦ No loitering or recreational activities allowed.
- ♦ Cemetery closed at dusk and is patrolled.
