PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the Township of Crockery will hold a public hearing on April 15, 2024, at 6:30 p.m., at the Crockery Township Hall, 17431 – 112th Avenue, Nunica, within the Township, on a proposed ordinance to amend the Zoning Ordinance of the Township of Crockery. The principal provisions of the proposed amending ordinance can be summarized as follows:

1. Definitions. The proposed ordinance would amend Section 2.02.56 to add a definition for Farm Labor Housing.
2. Uses Permitted By Right. The proposed ordinance would amend Section 5.02.17 to add a minimum acreage requirement and maximum occupants.
3. Use Regulations. The proposed ordinance would amend Section 10.02 to add farm labor housing as an accessory use to the Commercial Horticultural District, subject to the requirements of Section 5.02.17.

The proposed amending ordinance is on file and may be examined at the offices of the Crockery Township Clerk, 17431 – 112th Avenue, during Township office hours. All interested persons may attend the public hearing and comment on the proposed ordinance. Written comments concerning the ordinance may be submitted to the Township office, at the above-stated address, up to the time of the public hearing.
